Admissions Policy

The published admissions number at High Beech 2018-19 is fifteen.

There is no guarantee of a place for children living in the priority admission area. In the event of oversubscription, places will be allocated using the following criteria in the order given:

- Looked After Children and previously looked after children
- If the pupil at the time of admission has a brother or sister attending the school.
- If, at the published closing date for admission, the pupil's normal place of residence is in the school priority admission area
- children living outside the priority admission area but within Waltham Abbey (defined as residence in the priority admission area of one of the following schools: High Beech CE Primary, Leverton Primary, Upshire Primary, Waltham Holy Cross Primary and Hillhouse Primary schools);
- remaining applications

In the case of over subscription in any one category 'straight line' distance between the pupil's home and the nearest pupil entrance to the school, the pupils living closest will be given priority.
